Requirements for the availability of an internal quality assurance system in higher education

Approval of the procedure for assessing learning outcomes is carried out by the National Academy on the basis of the Regulations on the system of current and final assessment of students and cadets of Bohdan Khmelnytsky National Academy of State Border Guard Service of Ukraine, approved by the Head of the Academy from November 18th, 2019 №395.

The system of assessment of learning outcomes is based on such basic principles as:

validity is the assessment that should be commensurate with the level of learning outcomes;

impartiality is the results of the evaluation which should be objective and do not depend on the subjective position of those who evaluate, and the criteria and methods of evaluation - the same for all who are evaluated;

clarity is the evaluation system must be clear and absolutely defined in advance for those who evaluate and those who are evaluated;

usefulness is assessment that should be perceived by those who are evaluated, and be a contribution to the tasks of educational (professional program).

Learning outcomes should be commensurate with the competencies of the graduate.
